OUR CHILDREN AND FAMILIES IN CRISIS

On October 19, 2021, the American Academy of Pediatrics, American Academy of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry (AACAP) and Children's Hospital Association declared a national emergency in children's mental health, citing the serious toll of the COVID-19 pandemic on top of existing challenges.

Even before the pandemic, children's mental health was an area of growing concern in the United States. A 2016 National Survey of Children's Health data published in JAMA Pediatrics indicated that as many as 1 in 6 U.S. children between the ages of 6 and 17 has a treatable mental health disorder, while other research estimates that 17.4% of children ages 2-8 had at least one mental, behavioral, or developmental disorder.

For families seeking clinical help for their very young children, the lack of qualified clinical personnel to address this issue is another barrier. The 2020 Gardner Institute mental health report (Early Childhood Mental Health in Utah) highlights data from the American Academy of Child & Adolescent Psychiatry that shows "the ratio of child psychiatrists per 100,000 children in Utah is particularly low."



Early interventions are proven to increase children's current and future health, as well as reduce future use of services and treatment.

The Children's Center Utah is leading the way in this vitally important work, now for 60 years. Our work is key to effectively addressing Utah children's mental health crisis and helping the next generation grow into strong, resilient youth and adults prepared to take on life's challenges.





The average age of a child served at The Children's Center Utah is 3, with ranges from infant through 6. Although there are highly-trained mental health experts in our state, the treatment expertise for the youngest members of our population is extremely limited outside of our services. Most mental health professionals trained to treat children have received their education focused on older children (age 8 and above) and adolescents. The Children's Center Utah provides a unique and vital service in our communities by meeting the needs of very young children and their caregivers.

As the leading expert in infant and early childhood mental health, **The Children's Center Utah also** is taking intentional steps to help address the striking workforce shortages in our state through a unique, highly competitive residency program that trains the professionals who are desperately

needed. Supporting the next generation of specialized clinicians and other early childhood providers of all backgrounds is the only effective way to truly address the challenges and continue to work upstream with infants, toddlers, preschoolers, and their families and caregivers.

SECURED \$7M INITIAL **INVESTMENT** The sale of current Salt Lake location, the state's investment, and expedited fundraising from private philanthropy will provide a unique opportunity to capitalize on and escalate vision. Proceeds from sale of Salt Lake center are planned for program and operating expenses, and are temporarily directed toward capital costs for new facility.

LOCATED IDEAL SITE FOR NEW CAMPUS

CHILDREN'S MENTAL HEALTH CAMPUS TO OPEN IN WEST VALLEY CITY

Capital campaign major gifts will reach 75% of goal and coincide with timeline to celebrate opening of new facility in fall 2023.

Three additional priority areas for future site expansion to be identified: Utah, Weber/Davis, and Washington counties.

WORLD-CLASS CHILDREN'S MENTAL HEALTH CAMPUS

A THERAPEUTIC PLACE OF HOPE AND HEALING

The Children's Center Utah must expand its services to significantly impact and enhance the emotional well-being of Utah children and their families.

The Children's Mental Health Campus will be a center of excellence for evidence-based, trauma-informed mental health care, serving both the immediate needs of children birth through six and their families, as well as acting as a training center for early childhood mental health professionals of all backgrounds. This Campus will allow The Children's Center Utah to continue to lead the way in early intervention to improve the mental health outcomes for all Utahns by housing outpatient clinical services, a therapeutic preschool, and early childhood consultation and training.

This Campus also will serve as a launching point for a statewide expansion of The Children Center Utah's services over the next 10 years, providing a home for our Infant and Early Childhood Mental Health Education and Training Center dedicated to enhanced training that will facilitate workforce development and statewide collaborations and connections. Moreover, the facility will provide a home for ongoing research, program, and policy development. Three priority areas for future site expansion have been identified and include Utah, Weber/Davis, and Washington counties, with the Children's Mental Health Campus as the state's central hub.

Therapeutic Design

Promote hope and healing through design elements such as floor plan/flow, exposure to light/nature, artwork, texture, acoustics, physical safety, and technology.



Education and Training

Access and Growth

Location based on heat map research, centrally located to client population providing an easily accessible and safe location outside Salt Lake urban area, historically, a significant travel barrier for families.

Strong alignment with partnering organizations such as Huntsman Mental Health Institute, Primary Children's Hospital, along with Valley Behavioral Health children and youth services, which is located on the same Campus.

OUTPATIENT CLINICAL SERVICES EVIDENCE-BASED THERAPIES

We utilize effective and proven interventions that support the healthy development and well-being of young children

ATTACHMENT AND BIOBEHAVIORAL CATCH-UP (ABC)



An evidence-based, short-term treatment focused on helping caregivers provide nurturing care and engage in sensitive interaction with children. ABC utilizes two models, Infant and Toddler, and provides services for children six months to four years old.

ATTACHMENT, REGULATION, AND COMPETENCY (ARC)



An adaptive intervention developed for children who have experienced complex trauma, along with their caregiving systems. ARC identifies and addresses important childhood skills and competencies which are routinely shown to be negatively affected by traumatic stress and by attachment disruptions.

CHILD-PARENT PSYCHOTHERAPY (CPP)



A treatment focused on ways in which trauma has affected the parent-child relationship and the family's connection to their culture and cultural beliefs, spirituality, intergenerational transmission of trauma, historical trauma, immigration experiences, parenting practices, and traditional cultural values. A recent study by the Washington State Institute of Public Policy demonstrated a \$15.69 return per dollar invested in Child-Parent Psychotherapy.

TRAUMA-FOCUSED COGNITIVE BEHAVIORAL THERAPY (TF-CBT)




An evidence-based treatment approach shown to help children and their parents (or other caregivers) overcome trauma-related difficulties, including child maltreatment. TF-CBT also supports post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD), depression, anxiety, externalizing behavior challenges, relationships and attachment challenges, school and cognitive challenges. TF-CBT includes skills for regulating affect, behavior, thoughts and relationships, trauma processing, and enhancing safety, trust, parenting skills, and family communications.





DEVEREUX EARLY CHILDHOOD ASSESSMENT (DECA)

Our Therapeutic Preschool clinical team utilizes the Devereux Early Childhood Assessment to understand how each child is progressing in group treatment and uses each child's unique profile to help create a treatment plan that will best support their therapeutic progress in group. DECA assessments not only provide psychometrically-sound measurements, but also reflect "child protective factors" which offset or diminish the effects of risk adversity. Assessing these factors allows our team to focus on building resilience for each child through social and emotional support. DECA supports children by identifying areas of strength and need with respect to four key social and emotional skills






