



Master's Internship Program

The Children's Center Utah accepts students from Social Work, Mental Health Counseling, and Marriage and Family Therapy programs for our year long internship experience. The program runs on an academic year schedule in conjunction with our Doctoral Psychology internship program.

Master's students will get the opportunity to provide family therapy to clients, facilitate parent groups, participate in our Therapeutic Preschool Program, and coordinate with other programs such as our Psychology Testing Clinic and Psychiatry team.

Students will have the opportunity to participate in our two-week orientation, FAN (Facilitating Attuned Interactions), CARE (Child Adult Relationship Enhancement) and DC: 0-5 training, evidence-based treatment training for ARC (Attachment, Self-Regulation and Competency) and CPP (Child Parent Psychotherapy).

Additionally, students will have weekly individual supervision and weekly group supervision. Students have numerous opportunities to attend weekly team meetings and case consultations.

Important Dates:

***Applications are accepted beginning in December of the year prior to internship up to February of the internship year.**

***Interviews will be conducted between January and March, with placements being offered by the end of March.**

***Students may wish to begin internship in the summer to accrue hours. Students may begin accruing hours in June and will coordinate with their site supervisor for planning.**
